The First Missionary Journey Begins Acts 13



Introduction

We come to the final "dramatic turn" in Luke's "Second Treatise." Referencing again Jesus' words in 1:8, all that is recorded from this chapter onward will be the fulfillment of witnessing for Jesus "to the uttermost parts of the earth." The gospel will begin marching westward, and Paul will assume the major apostolic role throughout the remainder of the book.

Labors In Cyprus (13:1-12)

- 1) Who is listed in v. 1? What happens in vv. 2-3? (cp. 9:15-16; 26:16-18) For what purpose was this "laying on of hands?"
- 2) Where was the first stop on this journey? (vv. 4-5) Who was with Barnabas & Saul?
- 3) What happened when they completed their evangelistic efforts on Cyprus? (vv. 6-7a) Who showed an interest in the gospel? (v. 7b) What was working against his interest? (v. 8)
- 4) What information does Luke record in v. 9a that will be reflected in a majority of the remainder of the N.T.? *Thought question*: what is indicated when comparing 13:2, 7 with 13:13, 42, 46, 50?

5) How did Paul react to Elymas' opposition? (vv. 9b-11) What impact did this have upon Sergius Paulus? (v. 12)

8)	What were Paul's "words of exhortation?" (vv. 16-41) What "themes" did he emphasize? How is what he said similar to earlier "exhortations" recorded by Luke?
9)	What happened as Paul & Barnabas exited the synagogue? (vv. 42-43)
10)	What happened one week later? (v. 44) What did the Jews of Antioch Pisidia think of this? (v. 45) What was the apostles' response? (vv. 46-47)

11)	What impact did all this have on the gospel's efforts in that area? (vv. 48-49) <i>Thought question</i> : be able to explain v. 48b in light of Calvinistic teaching re: predestination.
12)	How did the Jews react? (v. 50) What did Paul & Barnabas do? (v. 51)
13)	How does Luke describe those who were converted? (v. 52)
