## Lesson Eighteen Study Questions – Walking on Water

(Matthew 14:22-33; Mark 6:45-52; John 6:15-21)

1. After the feeding of the 5,000, what did Jesus perceive that the multitudes were about to do? (John 6:15)
  - Leading premillennialist John Walvoord has said that, “There is much positive evidence in the New Testament for premillennial teachings. It is clear that the Jews rejected Jesus Christ as their King and Messiah.”
    - Is Walvoord’s claim in harmony with the actions of Jesus and the multitudes in John 6:15 and Matthew 14:22?
  - Where did Jesus send the multitudes? (Matthew 14:22)
  - Where did He send His disciples?
2. After sending away His disciples and the multitudes, where did Jesus go and why did He go there? (Matthew 14:23)
  - What was Jesus doing on each of the occasions mentioned in Luke 6:12; 9:18, 29; and 11:11?
    - What are we commanded to do in 1 Thessalonians 5:17 and Colossians 4:2?
3. When evening came, where was Jesus and where was the boat? (Mark 6:47)
  - What were the disciples doing and why? (Mark 6:48; Matthew 14:24)
  - According to John’s account, how far had the disciples rowed and toward what city? (John 6:17-19)
  - What time of night was it when Jesus began to walk toward His disciples on the water? (Matthew 14:25)
  - According to Mark’s account, Jesus was making such progress walking on the water that He “would have” done what? (Mark 6:48)
4. How do the disciples react when they see Jesus walking on the sea? (Matthew 14:26)
  - What does Jesus immediately say to them? (Matthew 14:27)
5. What does Peter say in response to Jesus? (Matthew 14:28)
  - Did Jesus command Peter to come to Him on the water? (Matthew 14:29)
  - Did Peter initially walk on the water to go to Jesus?
  - What did Peter see that made him afraid? (Matthew 14:30)
  - When Peter began to sink, what did he cry out? (Matthew 14:30)
  - What did Jesus immediately do? (Matthew 14:31)
  - What did Jesus say to Peter?
6. When Jesus and Peter got into the boat, what happened to the wind? (Matthew 14:32)
  - What did those in the boat do and say to Jesus? (Matthew 14:33)
  - How does Mark describe the extent of their amazement? (Mark 6:51)
